2010 AWOL One Loft Race Series

This is the only race series that allows you to choose which races you want to enter. You are free to enter only one race or any number of races. If you enter all races in a series, you are qualified for Series Average Speed

Accepting Entries February 1st – June 1st & Replacement birds till June 15th

No birds accepted without accompanying perch fees

All entry fees are due on or before August 28th

Entry payments postmarked later than August 28th, will not be accepted

If an entry is lost prior to a race, breeder's entry fee is credited to next year's Race Series

Each of the 5 Capital Prize Races, is released within a Southern California Federation race of up to 3200 birds. The loft is located on the long end of the Federation, so returning birds do not come in “drops”, but in singles.

The average time between the first and second “Clocked” birds in past races, has been six minutes.

Middle Series Average Speed: 150 + 220 + 300 Mile Races

Payout = 6% of Middle Series Entry Fees

Long Series Average Speed: 220 + 300 + 350 Mile Races

Payout = 6% of Long Series Entry Fees

Marathon Series Average Speed: 300 + 350 + 400 Mile Races

Payout = 6% of Marathon Series Entry Fees

Overall Average Speed: 150 + 220 + 300 + 350 + 400 Mile Races

Payout = 6% of All Entry Fees

Average Speed payouts equal 17% of total prizes

Each Average Speed Competition pays out 4 positions (40%, 30%, 20%, 10%)

Each Capital Prize Race pays out 15 prizes

For each of the five series races, the AWOL race birds will be released within the larger Southern California Federation race, of thousands of birds, heading to all parts of the San Fernando Valley and Greater Los Angeles / Orange County area.

From the release point, the birds must cross the San Joaquin Valley, then climb 3600 feet in less than 10 miles before traversing the 40 miles of passes which separate the Great Valley from the San Fernando Valley. About 1/3rd of the Federation birds will be dropping out to their Fernando valley home lofts, the remaining birds will cross over the foothills separating the Fernando Valley from the Greater LA Basin. Once these birds enter the Greater LA Basin, they have about 40 miles of flat terrain, over which to fly before reaching their loft. All along the way, Federation race birds will be spreading out across the basin and heading towards their home lofts, but the AWOL series birds will continue on, as their loft is on the long end of the Federation race course.

This unique series of races allows you to test your birds against the toughest competition, within a large federation release, where quality birds can show their stuff, competing in five races (1420 miles) over an eight week period.
